Welcome to the 7th running of the Adelaide Hills Rally, the only council/shire road-based event in the Australian Rally Championship. We are super excited to have Copyworld as our Major Sponsor for this year. This year we are back at the Summit Sport and Recreation Grounds for our Service Park and Rally HQ in Mount Barker. The event will start off with the MSS Safety Rally Show in the heart of Mt Barker on Morphett Street Friday evening from 6.30pm. There will be food trucks and music and plenty of time to mix with the locals. The Ballot for top 3 starting positions for Heat 1 will be done at the MSS Safety Rally Show, then the crews will be flagged off by local dignitaries over the start ramp.

The Stages this year will all be on local council roads. We really appreciate the 4 councils that we are operating in allowing us to run the event and the residents that we are affecting on these roads.

This year our remote service at Strathalbyn will be on the Saturday to allow the Power Stage to be closer to the finish at Mount Barker on the Sunday. There are also changes to the itinerary with new stages across both days for you to enjoy. The new stages are Kuitpo and Red Creek and we see the return of the Retreat Vally stage and a change to the Charligate and Back Callington stages.

This event will be the final round of the South Australian Rally Championship and the South Australian Regularity Series, making it essential for those that wish to be in the hunt for either championship to have a competitive weekend.














Use this guide to ensure safe viewing in areas outside designated spectator points

- Stand in a safe location

- Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move away quickly


- Stand in prohibited areas (study the spectator viewing diagrams)
- Stand or sit close to the edge of the road
- Stand or Sit below the edge of the road or in gutters & culverts
- Stand in a run-off / escape route for the competing cars
- Sit down at a location on the same level as the cars - you need to be standing so you are able to move away quickly if necessary
- Remove rally signs or arrows, or stand in front of them
- Be distracted always face toward the competing cars
- Stand or Cross a road that is officially closed
- play games with your safety, the competitors safety, or the safety of those around you
- Stand in front of fences or objects that may prevent you from moving quickly

From Terlinga Rd (Mt Torrens) turn into Black Heath Rd. Travel 2.7 kms on Black Heath Rd then turn right into Gladigau Rd. Travel 4 kms South on Gladigau Rd to the Spectator Point.

Caution is to be taken on these roads, they are dirt roads and can be slippery even in dry weather. Take care on Gladigau Rd, it is sometimes narrow and at 3.5 kms form the Black Heath Rd intersection there is an S bend though a creek crossing.

Galvaniize Insurance Rally Central Summit Sport and Recreation Park



Located 5 minutes from the centre of Mt Barker, the Summit Sport and Recreation Park on Springs Rd will be transformed into Galvaniize Insurance Rally Central.

Cars and crews will be coming and going throughout both days of the rally.

Food and drinks will be available on site or there is the Aston Hills Shopping Centre close by.



Strathalbyn Remote Tyre Change and Refuel



Located on Commercial Rd, Strathalbyn will be a remote tyre change and refuel for all rally cars. Commencing around 2pm on Saturday, crews will be setting up for the first cars to arrive around 2:20pm. Following that the cars will move into a Regroup for 30 mins on Albyn Tce before heading back out for the second pass through the Bugle Ranges and Wattle Flat stages.

Food and drinks will be available from the locals shops.
